

Art Appreciation: Volunteers present and discuss works of art in the classroom. No art history or artistic background needed! Discussions may be 30-45 minutes in length every 4-6 weeks, as classroom schedules allow.

Cultural Arts: Works with school administration to plan and organize an all school assembly as well as an author visit during the year.

Box Tops: Collect and submit participating box tops for redemption. Volunteers sort, cut, bundle labels, and organize monthly competitions to bring in more box tops.

Family Education Night: Committee plans and implements an evening of fun, math-oriented activities for Lions Park families.

Family Trivia Night: Committee plans and implements an evening of fun, trivia-oriented activities for Lions Park families.

Fifth Grade Activities: Volunteers organize social events for fifth grade students during their “graduating” year. This year’s activities include open gym, roller-skating, ice cream social, bowling and year-end picnic.

Fitness Is Fun: Volunteers help supervise students in the “Fitness Is Fun” program during lunch recess once a week throughout January.

Fun Fair: Committee plans and organizes our annual spring fun fair. Committee Chair and Volunteers are needed to organize food, games, prizes, etc. as well as work the day of the event.

Leapin’ Into Literature: Committee helps introduce new books to students during their library time. Volunteers are needed to read new books to their child’s class.

LRC (Learning Resource Center, aka the Library): Volunteers work in the LRC one morning or afternoon twice a month. Volunteer responsibilities include checking out books to students, shelving books, and working on projects in the LRC.

School Supplies: Helps coordinate the sale and distribution of boxed school supplies. School supplies are ordered in the Spring and are picked up in August of the following school year.

STEM Fair (Science Technology Engineering and Math Fair): Volunteers are needed to help organize, assist parents and children, set-up, and clean up at the fair.

Special Lunches: Volunteers are needed to help serve special lunch on the second Wednesday of every month.

Spirit Wear: Volunteers help with the ordering and distribution of Lions Park spirit wear (i.e. school sweatshirts, t-shirts, etc.).

Staff Appreciation Week: Volunteers help plan and assist with activities to honor our Lions Park staff throughout Staff Appreciation Week in May. Help is needed in planning the event as well as coordinating food, supplies, and staff gifts.

Turkey Shoot: Committee organizes a fun, family basketball hot shots event in which winning teams are awarded prizes. Volunteers are needed at the event to check-in teams and keep score.

Yearbook: This committee creates the yearbook. Volunteers from each grade are needed to take pictures and coordinate distribution of the yearbooks.

Miscellaneous: Volunteers interested in helping with activities, on an as needed basis, but not for a specific committee.
